

*April 25<sup>th</sup> Paulding SORBA partnered with Comcast Cable participating in a community volunteer project known as "Keep Paulding Beautiful". 50 volunteers from Comcast joined with Paulding SORBA on the Mount Tabor "Gateway" project recording 141 hours of trail work. Results brought the project to a 90% completion of the first core loop.*

*Paulding Trail Crew Leaders Dave Senecal, Scott Martin, TJ Jacobs, Tom Hutchinson, John Miller, Steve Houghton and Cres Summers lead the 50+ volunteers into work while Peggy Grimes & Derek Boyd manned the communications tent. The community crew from Comcast were all "new" not only to trail building but to the sport of mountain biking. After a hard morning of work the crew and volunteers were treated to a Chick-fil-A lunch. Many Thanks to our friends at Woodstock SORBA for loaning tools for the days event.*

*Mount Tabor Park is located on East Paulding Drive in Dallas, Georgia. Paulding SORBA signed an MOU in late 2008 with the Paulding County Parks & Recreation. The park area was once used by Mountain Bikers years before the Parks & Recreation developed the current state of the art facility. Paulding SORBA is "reclaiming" this land and developing a "GATEWAY" model mountain bike course for new comers to the sport as well as seasoned riders. The final project will have three loops and a bunny loop with approximately 8 miles of trail. The Mount Tabor project will also feature the "Boy Scout" bridge located on the core loop. An Eagle Scout is building this bridge and it is currently the largest Eagle Scout project in the Southeast.*

*Paulding SORBA continues to be creative in "Tapping" into the community for volunteer work. March "Make Your Mark" work party partnered with Starbucks Coffee recorded 201 volunteer hours. In July plans are under way to partner with "Engage Atlanta" Community project with over 38 local churches involved. Last year drew 150+ volunteer workers from the community on the two day event.*

*We also have re-aligned 9 miles of trail parallel to the Silver Comet Trail.*

*We have built almost 2 miles at Sara Babb park with plans to build more.*

*We have partnered with the Westside Bike League and the The ChainStation Bike shop to promote all forms of cycling.*
